A co-fermented blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mataro that displays openly fruity characters of lifted perfume and hints of cinnamon spice influenced by the Grenache.

This is enhanced with the influence of dark chocolate and dense layers of fruit and spice from the Shiraz and loads of strawberries and violets from the Mataro.

This wine was aged for 16 months in old oak barrels to preserve the intense fruit flavour and characteristics that this wine so openly displays.

This wine with its generous flavour and full body will compliment duck and venison dishes an excellent selection to accompany any game meats.
